Project Objective

The Paradigm Clean Cookstoves Project seeks to improve the health of Kenyan people through the provision of efficient cooking stoves.

More than 4 million women and children die each year from lower respiratory disease related to indoor cooking smoke.

Project Plan

To achieve this objective, the project distributes stoves and water treatment products to households and institutions in the local populations.

Projects Impact

Not only does this project reduce a substantial amount of CO2 emissions, but it also improves the living standard of the local populations. 300,000 people gained new jobs and economic growth through this project. Locals are able to save up to 35-65% fuel money by simply cooking with cookstoves. In addition, 157,00 trees have been preserved by houses using clean cooking stoves.
